

# FREE ACCESS TO VALLETTA

## AFTERNOONS & WEEKENDS

**STARTING  
2<sup>ND</sup> DECEMBER 2013**

As announced in the 2014 Budget speech, the Government, through Transport Malta, is implementing the first measure to encourage more people to visit Valletta in the afternoons on weekdays, and all day during the weekend.

As of the 2nd December 2013, no CVA charges will apply for vehicles accessing the charging zone after 1400hrs on weekdays and all day on Saturdays, Sundays and Public Holidays.

It is to be noted, however, that anyone accessing the charging zone in the morning or before 1400hrs on weekdays and staying more than 30 minutes will continue to pay the same charges as today.

### **Chargeable Hours & Applicable Tariffs (as of 2nd December 2013)**

Monday to Friday (08:00 – 18:00)  
Except for vehicles accessing the zone after 14:00  
and on Public holidays

Criteria	Charge
Access for first 30 minutes	Free
Access for 30 to 60 minutes	€0.82c
Access over 60 minutes	€0.82c per hour or part thereof (maximum charge of €6.52/day)
Access AFTER 14:00 on weekdays	Free
Saturdays and Sundays	Free
Public holidays falling on a day during which the charging zone is in force	Free
